Edge Network's ATSC 3.0 system is being used in their revolutionary Next-Gen TV service Evoca, to deliver 80+ live, local, entertainment and sports channels to customers in Boise, ID.

- MediaCast ROUTE/MMTP server in a 1+1 redundant configuration
- EdgeProbe Advanced ATSC 3.0 DTV transmitter monitor equipped with quad inputs
- Referee3 portable field receiver and RF signal analyzer
- VideoFlow IP-STL solution for reliable content delivery over an IP network connecting their NOC to the broadcast tower in Boise
- DASDEC-IR Intelligent Remote EAS receiver for the Boise DMA
